



Hope Mission is a not-for-profit Christian social care agency founded in 1929.

Today, Hope Mission cares for impoverished and homeless people in the city of Edmonton. Basic and emergency care, are provided to over 800 people daily, as well as counsel and referral services for men, women, and youth. In 2009 we provided 181,155 Emergency Shelter bed nights and our Food Services provided 394,278 meals. Specialized care and treatment is offered through faith-based addiction treatment programs. Hope Mission also facilitates an after school recreation and hot meal program for children; summer camps for inner-city children and youth; and operates a year-round Youth Sports Centre.

Hope Mission continues to reach out to the inner city community through special seasonal meals and events and personal contact. Counselors, chaplains and volunteers visit people on the street, in prisons, hospitals and other agencies.

In all, our desire is to provide compassionate care, and offer hope to hurting, hungry and homeless people in Edmonton.
