

## Camp Dates and Costs

### GO Team ages 13-15

Four sessions to choose from  
July 1-6, 8-13, 15-20, 22-25  
Cost: \$25

### Rhythm— A Youth Development Program ages 14-17

Two sessions to choose from July 29-August 10, August 12-23  
Cost: \$50

### Wrangler Training Program (WTP) ages 15-17

Guys Programs July 29 - August 23  
Girls Program July 1 -25  
Cost: \$100

### Leadership Development Program (LDP) ages 15-17

Two sessions to choose from July 1-25 or July 29 - August 23  
Cost: \$100

For the above 3 programs, campers go home on weekends and return each Sunday.

Although we encourage you to pay the fees for camp or to pay whatever you can afford, we want to stress that we do not want any youth to miss out on camp because of finances.

If you cannot afford to pay the fees, simply fill out the application form and mail it to us. Brightwood Ranch will gladly take care of the costs for you.

## Application Procedures

- \* Phone the camp for a special application form. Send it to camp. Acceptance is not on a first come first serve basis.
- \* We will reply confirming acceptance and provide further details (times, items to bring, and a complete medical form).
- \* Fees include meals, housing, insurance and all activities on and off site.
- \* Afternoon snacks are available in our Canteen. Maximum \$5.00 per week.
- \* **Free bus service** is available in Edmonton, to and from camp.

These programs are geared for teens who have an interest in learning more about God, a willingness to serve, a submissive spirit, and who would like to develop leadership skills in a camp setting.



## **Leadership Development Program (LDP) ages 15-17**

### **A four week training program**

**Week One** - A canoe trip. This trip will expose you to the outdoors, stretch your abilities, and help your group to grow together as you prepare for the next 3 weeks.

**Week Two**—The emphasis is on personal growth—leadership, service, discipline, etc.

**Week Three**—The emphasis is on camp activity skill development—archery, climbing wall, crafts, etc.

**Week Four**—You will spend this week with a cabin group learning how counselors interact with campers and helping campers to have a good time. All four weeks will have times spent in Bible study, service projects, camp activities and fun.

This program is for youth who already have some leadership experience or are ready to take on the challenge of leadership. We expect participants will have a higher degree of maturity. The program comes with more work, higher expectations and requirements to complete than the Rhythm program.



Question. Think. Grow.

**For ages 14-17**

Explore: Yourself. Your World. Your Limits.

This two week program will challenge you to expand your world as you know it. A time to think and question the idea of God and how that works into your life on a daily basis. An opportunity to push yourself further than you have before and experience new skills such as archery, wall climbing, horseback riding, and riflery. A chance to step away from all that you know and into the wilderness for a 3-4 day canoe trip. An occasion for growth and understanding; to walk more in Rhythm. Those who attend Rhythm will have the opportunity to participate in the full year Rhythm program located at the Hope Mission R.W. Tegler Youth Centre. This is for youth who may not be ready for the requirements and responsibilities of the LDP. It is more of an entry level leadership program.



**GO TEAM**

(AGES 13-15)

**The GO TEAM is a one week program where campers are involved in:** - service projects - camp activities  
- times learning about God

- personal growth times - outdoor experiences

**Graduates from this program may be eligible to come back to camp the following summer and take the LDP, WTP or Rhythm. The Go Team live in their own tent village a little separate from the main site. Three staff lead this program with 12 youth.**

## **Wrangler Training Program**

**(WTP)**

ages 15-17

A great way to:

- increase your knowledge and riding ability
- grow in your Christian faith,
- help kids to learn about horses,
- and learn what it means to minister in a camp setting.

**The training will consist of:**

- a 3-5 day horse trip to a 13, 000 acre grazing reserve. You will spend time riding out on the range, instruction time, sleeping in a tent and cooking your own food.
- grooming and tacking, horse knowledge and care, improving your riding ability, learning to be safe around horses, learning to teach kids, and learning to serve campers through Jesus.
- practical hands training by helping chore, groom, saddle and assist campers ages 6-13 in their riding time.

This program is not merely to learn about horses. The expectations will be high in regards to responsibilities and the requirements to successfully complete.
